NICOLAS VALAPERTA, being duly sworn, deposes and says:

1. I am a Vice President in Global Structured Finance (Global Corporate Trust Services) for U.S. Bank National Association (acting solely in its capacities as trustee, securities administrator, paying agent, and/or calculation agent, “USBNA”). I have been employed in this role since 2011.

2. The facts set forth herein are based upon (i) my personal knowledge, and (ii) information contained in USBNA’s business records, information supplied to me by other USBNA personnel, or information related to this matter.

3. As of the date on which this action was first filed, USBNA was trustee, securities administrator, paying agent, and/or calculation agent (as named in such role or as successor to the named party) for the seventy-seven residential mortgage-backed securitization trusts listed on Exhibit A to the First Amended Petition at NYSCEF No. 33 (the “Subject Trusts”).

4. After the First Amended Petition was filed, USBNA transferred substantially all of its corporate trust business to U.S. Bank Trust Company, National Association (“USBTC”), a


wholly owned subsidiary of USBNA. As a result of this transfer, USBTC has succeeded to all transaction roles (including but not limited to trustee, securities administrator, paying agent, and/or calculation agent) for the forty-six Subject Trusts specified on Exhibit 1 to the contemporaneously filed proposed Ex Parte Order Substituting Party and Amending Caption (the “Transferred Subject Trusts”), and USBNA no longer fulfills such roles for the Transferred Subject Trusts.



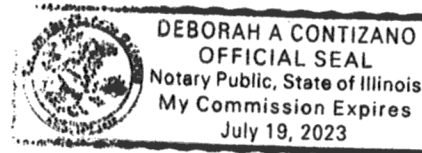
